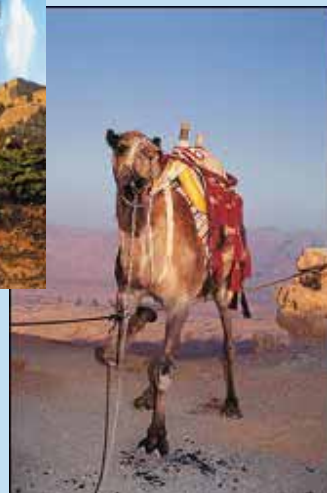
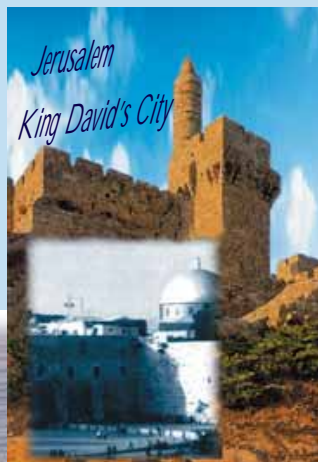

Module 3 - Anti-Sabotage

This instruction emphasizes detection and prevention, not disposal, of explosive threats. Methods of search techniques are covered as well as preventive procedures to implement as policy in public buildings, including how to prepare for threatening calls. Personality profiles of bomb threat callers and actual bomber motivations are explored in detail. While we do not expect to train bomb disposal technicians, we do hope to instill a sufficient level of knowledge so that our participant is capable, of establishing basic safety procedures, and knowing what to do during a bomb incident.

methods (Krav-Maga)

"Krav – Maga", which means "Contact Combat" in Hebrew, is the official martial art of the Israeli Defense Force and National Police. "Krav – Maga" is an extremely practical and effective defense against violent aggressors. Individuals can attain a high level of proficiency within a relatively short period of instruction.

Small arms to heavy weapons – how to recognize, know the effects Artillery and mortars – be aware of direction, blast and shrapnel Snipers modus operandi and preventive measures.
